This pertains to a phishing attack via email sent by DICT ADMIN <merle.aguilar@doe.gov.ph> with subject line "**Warning, Re validate Your Account**" wherein the recipient is advised to click a link to secure their account and will be directed to a fake website which will ask for personal information.

3. In this regard, all PNP personnel are advised to verify all incoming e-mails received to avoid possible security breaches. Once a message is received with the same description, immediately close the message, report it as a spam and inform ITMS thru the following:

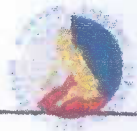

Good day,

Dear GovMail Admins,

Phishing is a fraudulent process used by spammers to acquire sensitive information from users such as usernames, passwords, and credit card details. Email recipients are often deceived by phishing attempts since messages appear to be sent by legitimate and trustworthy sources.

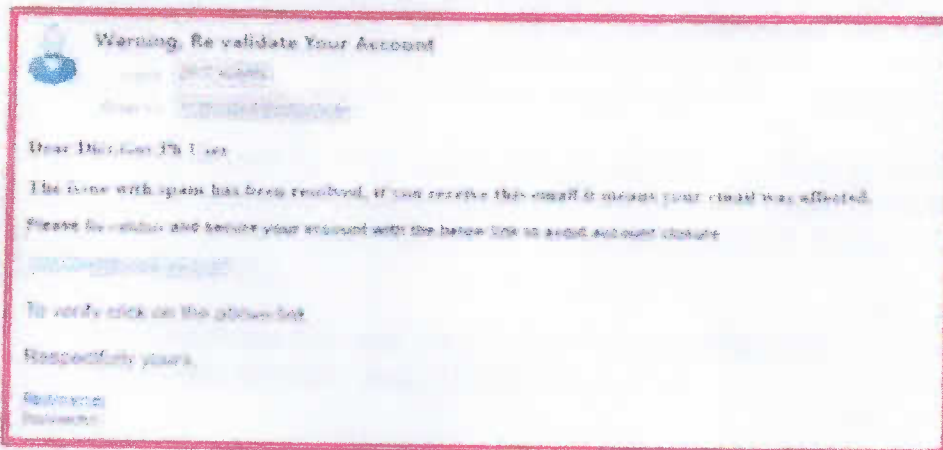
In recent days, we've learned of a new phishing attack that attempts to draw the attention of recipients with the subject line **"Warning, Re validate Your Account"** while the sender may appear to be **"DICT ADMIN <maric.aguilar@dic.gov.ph >"**

Users are directed to a fake website and asked to enter private information. In the event that you receive a message fitting this description, close the message immediately and report it as spam.

Our email traffic is filtered by the Spam Assassin and Antrarus service, which provides you with protection against dangerous viruses and spam. However, some spam may occasionally get through to your inbox or be diverted to your Junk Folder, so please be cautious.

If you happen to receive a message that appears to be spam or phishing, close the message immediately and report it at (02) 9200101 local 1703/6113 or email us at govmailsupport@dict.gov.ph.
